	PFTMP-3221	The "IA" box is displaying as a "Normal" box, i.e. not as an "Assistant" box	Assistant boxes, whether an "A" or "IA", should come in from the side and the issue here is that the "IA" box is not doing so.
320919	PFTMP-3238	Data Overlaps in PDF when Expandable Fields are Exported	Expandable fields, such as Job Title, Box Title and Name, will sometimes wrap to additional lines in the org chart. Previously, when these fields were exported to PDF, the text would overlap in the PDF chart if there were multiple lines. This issue has been corrected and the data will not overlap.
330093	PFTMP-3266	Individual Search does	Previously, if you performed a search, you would be taken to a page with a list of users and required to scroll through the list

		not Take the Searcher Directly to the Individual on the Org Chart	to locate the appropriate individual.This issue has been corrected an searches are now taken directly to the individual on the org chart.
336196	PFTMP-3281	PDF Export Index Header Not Using Field Labels	Previously, the PDF export index header was using the field name vs. the field label.For example, if an organization created a field label in an alternate language such as French, they would expect the index header to be displayed in French.Instead, the export would have the field name, which would export as English.This issue has been corrected and the field labels are now exported to the PDF index header.
336054,336469	PFTMP-3282	Conditional Background Color Used instead of Default Color when Viewing a Chart	Charts have a default background color, but in some cases can be assigned conditional background colors.Previously, when the chart was initially viewed, it would use the first conditional background color instead of the default color, where the conditional color should only be used when selected.This issue has been corrected and the initial chart view will be set to the default color.
343122,352286	PFTMP-3320	Chart Box Change Indicator Does Not Display	In legacy versions of the application, a pencil icon would display in the top-right corner of a chart box to indicate that a change had been made.In the most recent version, the icon was not displaying.This issue has been corrected and the icon will now display in the chart box when a change has been made.
	PFTMP-3334	Issue with Display of Text Placed outside of a Chart Box	In the most recent version, there was an issue with the way text placed outside of a chart box was displayed.The lines between adjacent boxes would run through the text.This issue has been corrected and the lines no longer run through the text.
347277	PFTMP-3335	Box formatting issue caused by space(s) in Record Type	When there is a/are space(s) in a custom position type, the box for that position type turns solid and cannot be formatted.
348235	PFTMP-3337	Issues with Chart Icons when Exported to PDF	Previously, when a chart with icons was exported to PDF, the icon would be displaced in the PDF output.In addition, it did not honor larger icons.The PDF export would still contain a smaller version.This issues has been corrected and icons are now exported as they are configured in the chart.
354673	PFTMP-3400	Issue with Talent	Previously, an issue with the Talent Management to OrgPublisher data sync was causing duplicate records in

		Management to OrgPublisher Data Sync	OrgPublisher.This issue has been corrected and data in no longer duplicated in the sync.
355183	PFTMP-3409	What-If Planning - unexpected error when creating a planning chart	When creating a planning chart in a span where the top box has a reports-to, and the "Allow to drill up" setting is enabled along with the entry box set as "Top of chart", the planning chart tries to use the top-of-chart's BoxID.This is corrected to use the top box 's Box ID for that span as top of chart.
	PFTMP-3412	Issue with Referencing a Numeric Field in a Formula	Previously, there was an issue when referencing a numeric field in a formula, where the precision was limited to five decimals.To work around this was to enter the numeric field in the formula vs. using the reference field.This issue has been corrected and the formula can now use the reference field.
