362831	NSD-10202	For courses loaded using the Rustici Engine integration, there was an issue recording the <code>cmi.interactions.n.student_response</code> (SCORM 1.2) or <code>cmi.interactions.n.learner_response</code> (SCORM 2004). This is corrected so these will be stored in the PFL database so they can appear on Report Wizard reports that include the "User Response" column.
379602	NSD-10197	There was a minor regression issue with the date format on the R202 report, this has been corrected.
	NSD-10192	The functionality to backdate the Award (Issue) Date on a Competency was not working correctly when editing a Competency and going to the User Review tab. This is fixed so the date will be correct based on the date entered by the administrator in the form.
378559,379611,379686	NSD-10191	There was an issue with the auto-enrollment setting for Completed Courses "Delay Processing # Days After Course Completion". This is corrected.

	PLC-746	When the Competency History is enabled, a "Granted" status was not able to be deleted using the Competency History Data Loader. This is corrected.
	NSD-10182	When the Competency History setting is enabled, the R139 report was showing different results for valid competencies. This has been adjusted to show the correct data.
378560	NSD-10177	When a Certification is set to expire on a specific date, there was an issue when learners first time earning the certification was after the second (or later) date. For example, if the certification was set to expire on 1 July 2023 and every 1 year thereafter, the next dates would be 1 July 2024, 1 July 2025, 1 July 2026. If a learner earned the certification on 15 July 2025, it would show the expiry as 1 July 2025. This is corrected so the next date (1 July 2026 in this example) will be the expiry for the certification.
	NSD-10164	The Group Certification Completion daily task was not optimized to handle customers with a large amount of certification history. The SQL needed for the task to process has been updated to avoid SQL Server Exception errors due to the volume.
373942	NSD-10163	When a user completes a module, then later re-enrolls before the previous module expires, the R139 report was showing NOT STARTED but the Learning Path was showing COMPLETED referencing the prior completion. The R139 has been updated to reflect this change.
	NSD-10155	Competencies can be configured to use the completion date of a module instead of the current date of the system. However, there was an issue with the display of the date in the UI, which was converting the time zone. This has been corrected so the date and time will appear correctly.
378497	NSD-10134	<p>In the LMS, the text displayed is translated using a key=value format. The key remains the same for all languages, as that is used by the system to look up the text to be displayed. In some cases, there are two keys with the same letters but different cases. For example, label.userattr2 and label.userAttr2 are both in the system and used in different places. When a customer wants to rename "User Attribute 2" to something else, the Customize Language Strings functionality can be used to store the translation.</p> <p>The issue here happened when upgrading from 25.02 (or a prior version) to 25.06 (or a later version) because there was a change to the length of one of the fields in the table. This change required dropping and re-adding the index, and that caused a failure when two "duplicate" strings were in the table. This has been fixed by detecting these case-insensitive duplicate records and deduplicating the language custom string records. Duplicates are removed in standard.properties. An on-screen message has been added to this functionality.</p> <p>NOTE: Impacted customers may need to re-submit one of the keys.</p>

378713	NSD-10135	PFL uses the default Java time zones, but they were showing incorrectly for Singapore and Qatar.This has been fixed for Java 17 (version 25.06 and higher).
366548	NSD-10104	Users who completed an exam were seeing their attempts deleted when re-launching an exam module after completion.This has been fixed to maintain the attempts./
378213	NSD-10080	In some cases, customers were reporting performance issues in loading exams.This change leverages the cache to reduce redundant queries.This should speed up the performance for exams.
	PLC-721	To provide clarification on the Specify most recent history event(s) to exclude option, a help indicator with a tool tip has been added.Hovering the mouse over the icon reveals the note: "Hold down the Ctrl or Shift button to select multiple events."
	PLC-719	The Manual Competency Revocation E-mail was not sending when revoking the competency also changed the proficiency level below the required level.This has been fixed.
	PLC-717	The Manual Certification Revocation E-mail Template will now correctly be sent when a user "deletes" a certification and Certification History is enabled.
377648	NSD-10031	There was a minor issue in the R139 Job Profile Compliance Report for courses that have equivalencies.If a user completed a course assigned to a competency as well as one of the equivalencies, the report would show COMPLETED BY SUBSTITUTE when it should just show COMPLETED.The "BY SUBSTITUTE" would only be when the equivalent course is completed, but not the assigned course.
377649	NSD-10030	There was a minor issue in the R139 Job Profile Compliance Report in the All Requirements Met column for more complicated data sets, typically for job profiles that have optional competencies and competencies that have optional modules.The logic for this column has been revised to account for this complication.
