## Features and Enhancements

The features and enhancements described in this section apply to PeopleFluent OrgPublisher and will be available when the client is upgraded to this version.

Because PeopleFluent OrgPublisher is configurable per client, new features may affect each client's individual implementation differently. For more information about any new feature, and how it can be used in specific implementations, contact your PeopleFluent representative.

#### Field Bulk Editor

### **Functionality**

This enhancement allows users with the appropriate permissions to edit properties on multiple fields at once.

#### **Details**

Users with the appropriate permissions can now edit some field properties on multiple fields at once using the Field Bulk Editor. The Field Bulk Editor page has two sections: Field Selector and Properties Panel.




Figure 1: Field Bulk Editor Page

#### **Field Selector**

Use the Field Selector section to filter fields by name, type, assigned to positions, and assigned to section. Fields can be sorted by the default sort order, selected fields, name, type, or section.

#### **Properties Panel**

The Properties Panel has three sections:

- **General**: Use this section to assign fields to a section, positions, or make them searchable.
- Formatting: Use this section to assign formatting to numeric or date fields.
- Security: Use this section to modify field security.

## Configure Default Position Type

### **Functionality**

This enhancement allows chart administrators to configure a default position type when a record in a data source does not contain a value in the Record Type field.

#### **Details**

Chart administrators can now use the Default Position Type field on the General tab to configure a default position type when a record in a data source does not contain a value in the Record Type field.




Figure 2: Default Position Type Field on the General Tab

## Branding and Logo Improvements

## **Functionality**

This enhancement consolidates branding and logo features onto a single page. From this page users with the appropriate permissions can resize images for the chart logo and upload an image for the header logo.

#### Details

Branding and logo features are now available on the Chart Logos page in the Admin web app. The page has two sections: Chart Logo and Header Logo.




Figure 3: Chart Logos Page

#### **Chart Logo**

In the Chart Logo section, users with the appropriate permissions can upload an image, which displays in the Chart Logo Image Preview panel. Users can resize the logo by clicking and dragging the red square in the bottom right corner, or enter values in the dimension fields, as well as choose to maintain the image's aspect ratio. If Aspect Ratio is not selected, the minimum size is 60 x 60 and the maximum is 2000 x 2000.




Figure 4: Chart Logo Section

### **Header Logo**

In the Header Logo section, users with the appropriate permissions can now upload a JPG or PNG image. The image is automatically scaled to a height of 40 pixels and the width will change automatically to maintain the aspect ratio.

In addition to the existing options to use a logo from a URL or use the PeopleFluent logo, users also now have the option to not display a header logo by selecting **No Logo**.

## Import and Export Group Definitions

## **Functionality**

This enhancement allows users with the appropriate permissions to export group definitions and then import them into other charts.

#### **Details**

Users with the appropriate permissions can now export existing group definitions as a means of backup, or to import into another chart.




Figure 6: Buttons to Export Groups

Exporting a group definition includes the group's name, icon, category, and criteria. Users can select individual groups or all groups in a category.




Figure 7: Export Group Definitions

Exporting groups does not include the data records that meet the group's criteria.

### **Imported Group Definitions**

Users with the appropriate permissions can import group definitions that have been exported from another chart.




Figure 8: Button to Import Groups

If an imported group's criteria includes other groups, then all of the information for those related groups are also imported. Custom icons used in imported group definitions are also imported if they do not exist in the target Charting web app.




Figure 9: Import Groups

If an imported group definition has the same name as an existing group, then the imported group's name is renamed. If an imported group's criteria includes an imported group that was renamed, then the criteria is automatically updated to reflect the group's name change.

An exported group definition includes the group category, if it is assigned one. When imported, the group is automatically assigned to an existing category if one with the same name exists. Otherwise the new category is also added to the chart.

### **Required Fields**

The target chart must be configured with all fields used by the imported group's criteria. An error message appears if a field is not configured in the target chart.




Figure 10: Required Fields

## Import and Export Data Source

### **Functionality**

This enhancement allows users with appropriate permissions to import and export data sources from the Admin web app.

#### **Details**

Users with appropriate permissions can now export data sources as a means of backing up a chart's data source.




Figure 11: Export Data Source

Exporting a data source includes its secondary data sources. Optionally, users can include the CSV files in the exported data source.




Figure 12: Include CSV Data

Exporting data sources does not back up databases or the database user's password.

#### **Importing Data Sources**

Users with the appropriate permissions can import a data source exported from PeopleFluent OrgPublisher. The file being imported must have the .opDatasource format.




Figure 13: Import Data Source

If the imported data source includes CSV files and any of the files have the same name as an existing file, then the Renamed CSV Files window appears.




Figure 14: Renamed CSV Files

If the imported data source uses CSV files that were not included in the export, the Import Complete window appears. Make note of any files whose status is missing as they will need to be located in the OrgPublisher Data directory on the server where the OrgPublisher Configuration Utility is installed.




Figure 15: Import Complete Dialog: Missing CSV Files

Once a data source is successfully imported, the user will need to complete its configuration.

## View Charting and Admin Web App Logs

### **Functionality**

This enhancement allows users with the appropriate permissions to view the Charting and Admin web app logs, and then filter and copy events.

#### **Details**

Users with the appropriate permissions can now access the Charting and Admin web applogs from the Web Apps page in the Admin web app.




Figure 16: Web Apps Page

The most recent log file displays by default on the Log Viewer page.




Figure 17: Log Viewer Page

Users can access older log files from the Log File drop-down menu, if they are available. Users can apply filters to the fields in the column headers to reduce the number of entries before copying entries to share for analysis.

The comparison operator now honors the numeric field type (number, integer, currency, or summary) and performs the operation correctly.

#### Known Issues and Limitations

The following are known issues or limitations of web browsers that may affect the PeopleFluent OrgPublisher Administration and Charting web apps:

- The PeopleFluent OrgPublisher Charting web app does not support printing from the web browser. Instead, PeopleFluent recommends using the Charting web app's PDF or PowerPoint export features, then printing from those applications.
- The PeopleFluent OrgPublisher Administration and Charting web apps do not support using Compatibility or Enterprise mode with any version of Microsoft Internet Explorer.

#### **Internet Access**

The PeopleFluent OrgPublisher Administration and Charting web apps require access to www.gstatic.com to render graphs.
