339227	NSD-8681	Evaluation workflow emails are not sending to users.	Optimized the customized feature of ING to send Grouped Evaluation Workflow Task to learners, similar to how it was optimized on the general feature of the Evaluation Workflow Send Email Task.
	NSD-8810	Withdraw enrollment functionality had a minor vulnerability.	A malicious actor could force one user to withdraw the enrollment of a different from a course by sending the first user a disguised link with the second user's data. This has been changed to ensure the user executing the withdraw command has permission to withdraw the second user, as defined by their role in the system.
	NSD-8811	Missing CSRF protection on Learning Modules list screen.	The Bulk Action function on the Learning Modules list screen was missing the CSRF token functionality to protect unsuspecting administrators from being forced to delete a module by an attacker.
345902	NSD-8877	Emails sent from the Catalog Editor were showing all recipients.	Within the catalog editor, there are two features that send emails to all selected participants: the Send Email functions on the Participants screen and on the Indicated Interest list. This caused some privacy concerns, so the functionality has been adjusted to send individual emails to the selected users.
343374	NSD-8904	Session Enrollment update was not considering enrollment availability.	When an admin wants to use the Session Enrollment update for a program, the enrollment availability set for each module (the "from" dates) will be honored and learners will not be enrolled if the from date has not passed.
346713,347492	NSD-8905	R201 was not including all question types.	The R201 report - Course Evaluation Summary for Specified Modules/Sessions - will now include all question types.

A defect was introduced in 2022 that can cause the database connections to remain open related to the user assignments.This has been resolved so the connection closes when it is no longer needed.It is being fixed in patches for 22.11, 23.03, and 23.07 as well as in the upcoming 23.11 release.
	PLC-229	SFTP Location pointing to a Windows server will support relative path	When the SFTP Location functionality was added in 23.07, when the location pointed to a Windows server the full path had to be added in PF Learning. With this fix, the URL can include the relative path on the server.
