About this Document

Introduction

In PeopleFluent Learning exams have three components: the exam, one or more exam sections, one or more questions per section.

The LMS includes a Question CSV Loader, which can be used to import questions only. However, you can import exams, exam sections and questions from comma-separated values (CSV) files via the Background Task Console. This can be particularly useful for migrating exams from another LMS.

To import an exam, its exam sections, and the questions for those sections, you have to create three Background Console tasks to import three CSV files populated with the corresponding data. You can then run the tasks immediately or at any time.

This document provides information for importing exams via the Background Task Console.



You can only add exams, sections and questions using the Background Task Console. Updating and deleting are not supported.

CSV Files

This section describes the fields needed for the CSV files to be imported. The order of the fields is not important, but they must all be present in the CSV file.

Main Exam CSV File Reference

When you import the main exam CSV file into the Background Task Console, the task type is *mainExamImports*.

Exam Section CSV File Reference

When you import the exam sections CSV file into the Background Task Console, the task type is *examSectionImports*.

The exam section CSV file adds exam sections to an existing exam. The CSV file can include multiple sections (one section per row). The exam sections are added in the same sequence as specified in the input CSV file.

Exam Sections Questions CSV File Reference

When you import the exam sections questions CSV file into the Background Task Console, the task type is *examSectionQuestionImports*.

The LMS supports two types of exam section: fixed question sections and random question sections. For fixed question sections, the OPML adds all active questions from the question pool. For random question sections, the OPML adds the specified number of active questions from the question pool.

Create a Scheduled Import Background Task

To import an exam, its exam sections, and the questions for those sections, you have to create three Background Console tasks to import three CSV files populated with the corresponding data (for more information, see CSV Files). You can then run the tasks immediately or at any time.

Administrators with unrestricted or read only access to the *System Administration* feature in System Roles (Manage Features > System Administration) can create scheduled import and export tasks in the Background Task Console.

To create a scheduled import background task

Go to **Manage Center > System > Background Task Console**. The Background Task Console page opens and lists any existing scheduled tasks.

- 1. Click + Add Tasks. The Add Background Task page opens.
- 2. Select **Import** from the Task drop-down list.
- 3. Select the frequency it will run.
- 4. Enter a title for the task.
- 5. Enter the task type corresponding to the CSV file:
 - mainExamImports for importing the exam
 - examSectionImports for importing the exam sections
 - examSectionQuestionImports for importing the exam section questions
- 6. Enter the URL for the imported or exported file. Files must be on the server or accessible from it.
- 7. Enter an email address for the task's start and end notifications.
- 8. Click **Save**. The task is added to the list on the Background Task Console page.
- 9. Repeat steps 1 to 8 as required to create the background tasks for all three CSV imports.
- 10. Click Run for each task to import the CSV files.
