Introduction

When integrating with or migrating from other systems, it is often necessary to be able to import and export data in bulk. This document discusses:

- The data object types that can be imported to and exported from PeopleFluent LMS.
- The required data formats.
- Support for scheduled imports and exports.

Standard CSV Loaders General Information

For each CSV Loader there is typically a page in the LMS from where you can:

- 1. View an import history
- 2. Download Log File for a given upload
- 3. Download CSV Error Report for a given upload
- 4. Download a CSV file template
- 5. View CSV Formatting Help
- 6. Start an upload
- 7. Select uploads for bulk deleting



Each loader will also have a corresponding report to export data in the format recognized by the respective Loader.


Preparing CSV Files for Importing

A recommended strategy is to set up a desired object, for example, a user or a course, through the UI, then use the relevant report to export the object to use as a template for the bulk creation of similar objects.

Note that .csv files are likely to be opened by Microsoft Excel if it is installed on your system. If you encounter any problems with importing a CSV file, it could be caused by Microsoft Excel applying extra formatting to the file. Ideally, the .csv file should be modified using a text editor instead of Microsoft Excel. The data should conform to the formatting required by the template as specified in the corresponding CSV Formatting Help. Do not insert commas as these will cause subsequent data to be treated as a separate column.

Importing Files

Go to the Loader appropriate for your data import and click the "Import CSV File" button.




You will be able to specify the following general properties for each import:


- 1. CSV File
- 2. Description (max 255 characters)
- 3. Encoding
- 4. Delimiter

If applicable, you will be presented with other import settings that are specific to the data loader.

Click Preview to view the uploaded document and click Upload to start the import:



After the import has been processed, a Summary Report will be displayed:



Log files and error reports will be accessible from the Loader's landing page.

Setting Custom Attribute Values

Custom Attributes can be set up in the system for certain object types, for example, Users, Organizations, Modules, and Sessions. To use the data loaders to set values against these custom attributes, add a column for each attribute with the header being the attribute code prefixed with:

- "OA-" for Organization Attributes in the Organization CSV Loader
- "UA-" for User Attributes in the User CSV Loader
- "MA-" for Module Attributes in the Course CSV Loader and Program CSV Loader
- "SA-" for Session Attributes in the Course CSV Loader and Program CSV Loader
- "QT-" for Session Attributes in the Question CSV Loader

Depending on the attribute type, the loader will expect different values:

- Free Text Attributes will expect any text as values
- Checkbox Attributes will expect "Y" or "N" as values
- Number Attributes will expect a number as values
- Drop Down Attributes will expect an Attribute Value Code.

Validation

Though there is no need to validate any image, audio or video URL, you should nevertheless do so before entering the URL in the template.

- "Create Learning objects for new Learning IDs found in the file": If the training records relate to courses that are not yet in the LMS, enabling "Create Learning objects for new Learning IDs found in the file" will have learning objects created automatically. The default value for this option is defined by the System configuration: "Automatically create learning objects when using dataloader". If this option is checked, the system will create Learning Objects for the given information. Otherwise, it will report an error if learning object id is not right or updates the record.
- "Skip Enrollment Checks": The standard enrollment process involves checks against prerequisites, seat numbers, approvals, etc., which can be very resource-intensive. - If there is no existing learning module with the specified Learning ID, a new learning module of type Classroom will be created with the specified ID and title; otherwise, the title field of the existing learning module will be updated.

Language Column in Training History CSV Loader

The purpose of the Language column is to accommodate the association of a language to a transcript record. It could have implications on various loader-triggered actions like creating a new learning object, creating a new session, adding a transcript or updating on an existing transcript without changing too much of its existing behaviors. Also the multi-language handling behavior of the loader should be consistent with the workflow on the UI.

- Creating a new course It involves creating a new session in the primary language. If a language is specified then it would perform the standard checking to see if the person doing the upload can create a primary bundle using that specified language otherwise the loader would raise an error on that transcript record. If the language is not specified then it would assume the default behavior to assign the language to the new session same as on the UI.
- Creating a new session on an existing course It would be applicable for multi-session learning types. The new session should be assigned with one of the existing languages configured on the course. This needs to be checked when a language is specified for the record. If the language is not specified then use the primary language to be assigned to the new session.

- Inserting a transcript on an existing session For learning types with online content, if a language is specified, check to see if the bundle exists already, this loader doesn't allow creating a new bundle on-the-fly. If a language is not specified then try to use the system default Auto-Select mechanism to assign the transcript with a language. For multi-session learning, use the existing behavior to identify the correct session to add the transcript to and ignore the language if it's specified as the enrollment should use the session-assigned language for the transcript.
- **Updating on an existing transcript** Use existing means to identify the correct transcript to update and language is ignored if specified.

Transcript Status Change via Training History Data Loader

Similar to Catalog Editor, any status update of the latest transcript via Training History Data Loader may also affect the award of certification or competency.

However, some restrictions are applied to Training History Data Loader. In general, an update action may update multiple matching existing records, except the case when changing the status to "Completed". In such an exceptional case, as only the latest transcript can be changed, an exception will be thrown. This means that no backdating support is available when there are multiple transcript records found.

Insert a new transcript record, latest or historical, using loader

In the LMS with CFR license, when using Training Records CSV Loader to insert a new transcript record in Completed status, the award of job profile or competency will be based on the definition of the job profile or competency as of the completion date. The award of certifications is typically based on the course details as at the completion date, but you can override this date in the USE SETTINGS AS OF DATE field.

Improve Dates/Status Handling in Training Records Loader

In general there will be enrollment checks when a training record is uploaded. If the optional Enrollment Date field is not specified, the start date will be taken. And if start date is not specified or it is a future time, today will be taken as the Enrollment Date.

Basic validation is applied. Also this value cannot be after start date or in the future. When uploading a COMPLETED program record. There will be further enrollment checks.

- Online equivalent Program Modules will take the same start/end dates as the program record
- Classroom equivalent Program Modules will take the scheduled start/end dates
- Mandatory Program Modules will take status of COMPLETED

Once a user that has no permission to remove a course uses the CSV file, the system will not permit the deletion and included an error report or failure notification in the log file.

Check Access on Course-Related CSV Uploads

For enhanced data security considerations, when a user attempts to import data using the Program CSV or Course CSV format via the user interface, scheduled task or API, the LMS checks if the importer has write access of the learning objects concerned.

For the following fields used in a data import, the LMS checks if the importer has at least read access to the object before the object can be assigned to the course in question

When a user attempts to import data through Catalog Assignment CSV Loader via the user interface, scheduled task or API, the LMS checks if the user has the read/write access to the catalog structure concerned.

'Use Defined Catalog Image' Option Considerations

The Course CSV and the Program CSV loaders support the Catalog image inheritance option from the course for the Knowledge Center. The value is a valid URL for an image, e.g. http://www.abc.com/abc. png or /ekp/nd/fresco/repository/EKP0002343.jpg.

These attributes are intended for some very specific use cases and are NOT for general loading of complex SCORM/AICC course materials (use the provided content loaders for this case), and because of this some constraints have been placed on the supported scenarios to avoid accidental mismanagement of more sophisticated launch interfaces. The specific scenarios where these attributes can help are:

Use Case #1: Creating or updating online courses that use a PDF, URL, or video/player as the primary content.

Creating courses from internal materials (e.g. videos and PDF) is a common need for organizations with numerous ISO materials or transitioning from older systems. Now, the Course CSV loader may be used to bulk create and manage a large number of such courses. The "Launch..." parameters in particular can be used to create or modify the launch page, although this is restricted to a limited set of interface types: "Generic Web Launch", "Resource", or "Timed HTML" only. These are typically the interfaces used for this type of course.

Example values for a Generic Launch Interface that references an item in the LMS Repository:

Use Case #2: Modifying general parameters for online (or equivalent) course types.

The "Online..." properties may be set for any online equivalent course type at either course creation or course update time. If it is not an "online equivalent" course type it is ignored.

Use Case #3: Creating or updating online courses to use an LMS exam as the content.

Here, the "Launch.Interface" set to "Resource" and the "Launch.ExamId" set to "<whatever exam ID>" is all that is needed. Other internal properties are set accordingly when the system detects that a "Launch.ExamId" is provided.

Example setup of a specific LMS exam as a launch URL:

A learning object of type 5 (Resource) can have either an external URL or an Exam ID as its launch URL, but it cannot have both.

Certification Awarding CSV Loader

A user is able to bulk award certifications via the Awarded Certificates CSV Loader in Management Center. In order to perform this bulk awarding action, the user needs to have Unrestricted role access to Awarded Certificates CSV Loader. Read only means the user can see the CSV import history only, unable to perform bulk awarding.

Use the following guide in creating certificate data file (CSV).



As the LMS is not configured to automatically change the file type after import, you have to manually rename your .csv file into .imported. This is make sure that the certificate records will not be imported multiple number of times.

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Validation will be performed on each row of uploaded file. Validation rule is consistent with Equivalency Rule user interface.

For rule deletion, when more than one rule of exact target and substitute are found, Talent Suite will delete matched rules which the uploader has the required permission. If deletion of all matched rules cannot be done, Talent Suite will report the number of matched rules found and number of rules deleted.

If the "Highest Organization Level Visible" of an uploader is "Root", a checkbox "Apply Target Audience to All Organizations" will be shown in loader. If the checkbox is checked during upload process, all the new rules created will have root organization as target audience.

A report "R264 – Course Equivalency Rule Export in CSV Data Uploader Format" is available under Learning Reports in Report Manager.

- It generates course equivalency rule data dump of the same column format as CSV data loader. The value of "Action" column defaults to "D".
- It reports on equivalency rules for selected target. The module selector is available to select multiple targets.
- It lists rules which the report requester has at least read permission.

For clients who have been using the old data loader format, it's recommended to convert the competency data output into this new format for bulk processing. For backward compatibility, it's possible to continue to use the old format by enabling a new back-end property "COMPETENCY.DATALOADEROLDFORMAT" defined in the ekp.properties file:

competency.dataLoaderOldFormat=true

For on-premise installation, a scheduled server restart is required to turn this switch on, the server administrator would need to make the above change in the properties file; for hosted solution, this change can be requested via the standard Support channel. If this switch is turned on, accessing the Data Loader via the Manage Center would support the old CSV format.

Data Dump Report

"R420 – Competency Export in CSV Data Uploader Format" is available under System Reports in the Report Manager. It outputs existing competency definitions in the same format as the data loader.

The report would export existing learning module assignment records as separate records. If there are 3 learning modules assigned, 3 records are exported, the properties of the same competency are repeated. If there is no learning module assigned, only 1 record with the existing competency properties is exported.

Adding an Owner to the Job Profile Data Loader

If Multiple Assignments is **disabled**, users can enter a user ID (PID) in JobProfileOwner column to identify the owner of the job profile.

If Multiple Assignments is **enabled**, there is an extra column JobProfileOwnerAssignmentId in the CSV template, to specify the assignment ID (Assignment Ref Code) of the owner.

If the job profile owner specified only has one assignment:

- If JobProfileOwnerAssignmentId column is left blank, the system will only consider the JobProfileOwner column.
- If JobProfileOwnerAssignmentId is defined, the JobProfileOwnerAssignmentId needs to match the JobProfileOwner.

If the job profile owner specified has more than one assignment

• JobProfileOwnerAssignmentId needs to match the JobProfileOwner.

Token Account CSV Loader

To access the loader, go to **Manage Center > LEARNING > PAYMENT MANAGER > Token Account Data Loader**. It can be used to perform two actions: initialize token accounts and add tokens to token accounts.

A token account must be created before tokens can be added. A token account name can be specified. If not, it will be generated based on the specified organization to which the account is assigned. Tokens added to a token account will be grouped by expiry date.

The data loader works like other data loader in the Talent Suite application and online help on CSV formatting is available on the main page, where a CSV file template is also available for download.

The 'UserId' in the CSV data format allows a user ID to be specified, from which the user organization will be derived. The organization to which the user belongs will be used in the data upload.

QTI Question Loader

Talent Suite offers partial support for the IMS Question & Test Interoperability Specification v1.2.1, which defines an XML language for describing questions and tests. The system can import multiple choice questions and question pools from an IMS QTI document at Question QTI Loader at in the Manage area.



QTI Version

We do not support IMS QTI v2.x, which unfortunately is entirely incompatible with the 1.x versions. We made a conscious decision to support the earlier version as we believe it is the more widely supported of the two.



- 6. Run a task on demand


Adding a Task

To add a new task

- 1. Specify if task is an Export or Import
- 2. Specify the Frequency (Hourly, Daily, Weekly, or Monthly)
- 3. Provide a Title for the Task
- 4. Specify the type
- 5. Specify a URL for the import/export file. The following schemes are supported:
 - file: (exported data is written to a file on the local file system)
 - ftp: (exported data is uploaded to a file on an FTP server)
 - http://https: (exported data is submitted using HTTP POST)

If the URL points to a directory when the file: scheme is used, the importer will scan the directory for all files that do not have the .imported file name extension. Every matching file will be processed and then the .imported file extension added to the file name.

Hourly Schedules

Tasks defined in imports-hourly.opml and exports-hourly.opml are run on the hour, every hour.

Daily Schedules

Tasks defined in imports-daily.opml and exports-daily.opml will be run daily. You can configure the hour of the day at which daily tasks are run by setting the value of the system.handlerstarttime property in WEB-INF/conf/ekp.properties. The value should be an integer between 0 and 23 inclusive. By default, daily tasks run at 3 a.m. For example, the property below configures daily tasks to run at 11 p.m.

system.handlerstarttime=23

Weekly Schedules

You can configure the day of the week on which weekly tasks are run by setting the value of the syste m.handlerStartDayOfWeek property in WEB-INF/conf/ekp.properties. The value should be an integer between 1 and 7 inclusive, with 1 denoting Sunday and 7 denoting Saturday. By default, weekly tasks run on Sunday. Weekly tasks run at the same hour of the day as daily tasks. For example, the property below configures weekly tasks to run on Saturday.

system.handlerStartDayOfWeek=7

Monthly Schedules

Monthly tasks always run on the first day of the month, at the same hour of the day as daily tasks.


