Add News to the Login Page

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#### **About this Document**

#### Introduction

This guide explains how to configure the PeopleFluent LMS login page to display news defined in the News Manager This allows up-to-date news articles at login without requiring the administrator to modify the login HTML.



This feature uses the Velocity template engine. You can read more about using Velocity at http://velocity.apache.org



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#### **Create a News Article**

To create a news article, go to Manage Center > Communicate > News Articles.

- 1. Click + Create News Article.
- 2. Complete the properties as required. You can select a file attachment as well as directly enter news text into the text field. If you provide a file attachment URL, an icon is added to the article for users to download it.




3. Click **Save** at the bottom of the page.

# **Configure a News Article for Display**

To configure a news article to display in the login page, go to **Manage Center > Communicate** > **News Articles**.

- 1. Create or open a news article for editing.
- 2. On the **Target Audience** tab, select the **Login Page** checkbox.



3. Click Save.

#### **Feature Behavior and Limitations**

News Articles have the following behavior and limitations:

- An article can be targeted at a specific set of recipients except when it is targeted to the login page. Because users are not logged in at the time the news is displayed on the login page, targeting cannot be applied.
- Surveys cannot be linked to login page news.
- Article controls, such as expiration dates and display order will also apply to login page news.
- Because the news query and display process is an LMS transaction, and uses Velocity, this
  will not work with login pages that cannot be converted (in whole or in part) and placed
  within the Tomcat WEB-INF/conf directory (or equivalent in JRun and others) as
  described later. For example, such as when the login fields have been embedded inside
  another portal or Intranet page.

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
