380012	NSD-10268	Regression issue for withdrawing from programs	In 24.09, a change was made to prevent learners from withdrawing from a program when the underlying modules had a withdrawal deadline. However, the change inadvertently prevented withdrawal unless the modules also permitted withdrawal. This posed an issue as learners could withdraw from one module and thus never complete the program. In this patch, the fix will allow programs to withdraw even if the modules are not set to allow withdrawal, if withdrawal deadlines for one or more of the submodules has not passed.
379918	NSD-10223	Restoring the exam bookmarked questions	In the initial launch of 25.06, the bookmark functionality for exams with Allow Section Navigation was removed as part of the redesign of the Exam player. This feature has been restored.
379557,379639	NSD-10200	Fixed issue with	In 25.02, Programs were updated to support cohort-based learning, with settings that existed for Classroom sessions -

		Program session that would not open.	including enrollment limitations. There was a minor issue related to the waitlists (reserved seats) in a program session that has been corrected, allowing sessions to open correctly.
	NSD-10154	Issue with Competency changes when the Update awarded competency issue date when training is completed again is enabled.	The setting "Update awarded competency issue date when training is completed again" allows competencies to be "re-issued" before they expire, when the training requirements are met again. However, if a reviewer changed the proficiency level this was reverted by the automated task. To correct this, a new System Configuration option "Update awarded competency proficiency level when training is completed again" is added, which requires the "Update awarded competency issue date when training is completed again" setting. Splitting this logic allows customers to decide whether an edited proficiency level should be retained.
	NSD-10284	Issue with Certification History report in Report Wizard	The Certification History report type in the Report Wizard had some issues when the Enable Certification History setting was enabled and columns for the Certification History were selected. The SQL would try to join tables in a way that didn't return any data. This has been corrected.
