385231	NSD-10647	Issue opening Questions with a period in the ID from the Exam Review page.	In 25.10, there was security update related to the Content Security Policy header. That change caused a downstream issue in the Exam Review page where Questions with periods in the IDs were mistakenly treated as CSS selectors, and not opening when clicked. This has been corrected.
385130	NSD-10635	issues printing Exams with a period in the ID from the Exam Schedule page.	In 25.10, there was security update related to the Content Security Policy header. That change caused a downstream issue on the Exam Schedule page (part of the limited Exams license) where Exams with periods in the IDs were mistakenly treated as CSS selectors, and not opening when clicked. This has been

			corrected.
385040,385113	NSD-10624	R139 issue with the module status after the valid for period expired	There was a minor issue in the R139 report that would incorrectly show a module as being completed after the validity period for the module against the competency. The issue was caused when an earlier enrollment was completed, but there were later enrollments where the user was withdrawn. This has been corrected to show the correct module status.
385083	NSD-10625	Issue opening Exams with a period in the ID.	In 25.10, there was security update related to the Content Security Policy header. That change caused a downstream issue on the Exam Manager page where Exams with periods in the IDs were mistakenly treated as CSS selectors, and not opening when clicked. This has been corrected.
384319	NSD-10621	Issue with the Assign Training screen when selecting a program session using the drop down configuration	When using the Assign Training function, and the "Directly display all learning program sessions." system configuration setting is disabled, the session selection drop down will have a Go button. This was not working, because of a regression issue in 26.02. This has been corrected.
383770,385107	NSD-10607	Minor language key issue on R139 report.	A minor language issue was created in 25.10.3 using "Deadline Expired" instead of "Expired" when fixing a defect. This is corrected to use the "Expired" language string.
384208	NSD-10605	Issue with R139 report not showing competency expiration correctly	The R139 was not showing the expiration of some competencies, this was corrected with a change to how the report retrieves the expiration dates from the database.
383987	NSD-10577	Competency expiry dates were sometimes missing or not displayed correctly in the UI, especially after data imports or course substitutions.	The competency expiry date display issues were related to data synchronization, import processes, and the handling of substitute courses. To resolve this issue, substitute course expiry info is hidden in the UI when it is outdated or incomplete. As part of this fix module

			expiry dates will be excluded from R139 reports when they were not relevant or available - based on the same criteria for hiding the date in the UI.
383606	NSD-10506	Issue with capitalization of Exam ID in Exam Data Loader	The Exam Data Loader will force the Exam ID to be all uppercase when using the loader to add an exam. However, there are instances with some older customers where existing exams has mixed case (Exam_Id), and there are issues when using the Exam Data Loader to with the update action. There are also issues on the Exam Listing page when there are exams with mixed case IDs. These issues have been corrected.

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
